INCLUDED IN PRICE: Round Trip Airfare as per brochure, Deluxe Motorcoaches, First Class / Superior First Class Hotels, Guided sightseeing, Entrance fees to sites visited, Breakfast & Dinner daily. A total of **\$628 USD** taxes comprised of fuel charges of **\$297.60** (subject to increase by airline up to 30 days prior to departure) and taxes of **\$330.40**. These taxes include Federal inspection fees for the U.S. Customs and Immigrations; international air transportation tax; agricultural tax; other per person taxes imposed by government entities; airport taxes and fees including the September 11th Security fee up to \$10 per person, passenger facility charges up to \$18 per person, federal domestic flight segment fees up to \$3.50 per segment and U.S. and International arrival and departure, and other government imposed fees up to \$300 per person. Also included are gratuities of **\$150.00** to your tour guide or cruise director, local host, driver, local guides, and/or ships' crew: gratuities on ferries, trains, and cruise ships.

NOT INCLUDED IN PRICE: Not included in your package are port taxes; passports; visas and vaccinations; tips to your laundry; telephone; mini-bar; alcohol, beverages, and food outside of the contracted tour operator menu as presented at a hotel or restaurant (these extra items will be billed to you before leaving the hotel, ship, or restaurant); optional excursions; airport transfers on non-qualifying flights; portage at airports and train stations; Group Travel Protection premiums; excess baggage fees; and all other items not specifically mentioned. Any fees or fuel surcharges imposed by the airlines or cruise lines after the date you register for your trip.

PAYMENT: A full deposit of **\$500 per person is required at time of registration**. Final payment for trip must be made in the form of a check (credit cards are not accepted for final payment), including optional group insurance premium if applicable, is due no later than **90-days prior to departure**. Thereafter, a late payment fee of \$95 will be assessed. Registrations received after 90-days prior to departure **must be accompanied by full payment**. All tour prices are based on a minimum group size of 20 passengers for prices to be valid.

If group size is less than 20 a supplement to price will apply. **Imagine** reserves the right to add a surcharge if the dollar declines by more than 2% against the shekel or euro based on foreign exchange rates in effect on date when your tour was booked by your tour leader/church.

ACCOMMODATIONS: Price is based on double occupancy. When available, single rooms are often smaller than doubles. While **Imagine** will try to match roommates, we cannot guarantee one will be available. Roommates may be assigned as late as 35 days prior to departure and, if one is not available or if you request a single room, you will be charged for a **single room: \$545** for basic itinerary.

ITINERARY and CHANGES: Because airlines often change flight schedules after brochures are printed, **Imagine** reserves the right to shorten or lengthen the itinerary accordingly and, whenever possible, you will be notified in writing. If itinerary changes necessitate extra overnights, you will be charged \$175 per night/per person; single rooms \$215 per night. Meals for extra night are not included. Any changes and/or deviations from the program and/or departure city listed by the passenger must be provided in writing to

Imagine Tours & Travel no later than 70-days prior to departure. All tours are finalized at 60-days prior to departure and there are no changes or additions to the tour after that time.

AIRLINE TICKETS: In order to keep prices low, **Imagine** does not guarantee the most direct routing to your final destination. Once printed, airline tickets cannot be changed or refunded thereafter. Air transportation to/from your destination will be economy class aboard IATA and ARC carriers utilizing APEX or SUPER APEX non-refundable, non-amendable tickets for groups of 10 or more flying together for entire itinerary. **Imagine** is unable to use individual frequent flyer points to upgrade or accept as partial payment for air transportation.

VISAS: Applicable visas will be obtained by **Imagine** for U.S. and Canadian Citizens only. All passengers who do not carry U.S. or Canadian Passports will be responsible for obtaining visas to the countries they are visiting, **Imagine** is not responsible for non-U.S. & Canadian Passport holders.

FLIGHT TIMES: All flight times are subject to change by the airlines without advance notice. **Imagine** is not responsible for such changes or delays and does not reimburse expenses resulting from such delays. If making your own flight arrangements to a departure city, we recommend you purchase a ticket which can be changed without large penalties. Day 1 - Monday: Depart USA

Tour members meet for our international flight to Israel. We make our connecting flight in Philadelphia or Newark where we change planes and board our non-stop flight to Tel Aviv. After take-off from Philadelphia, we will be served meals according to flight schedule.

Day 2 - Tuesday: Arrive Tel Aviv, Galilee

We arrive in Tel Aviv where we are met by our agent who assists us through customs and security. We are then transferred to our motorcoach and begin our drive to the Galilee, where we will overnight for the next three nights. Welcome dinner and overnight in Tiberias.

Day 3 - Wednesday: Galilee, Mt. of Beatitudes, Capernaum. Boat Ride on the Sea of Galilee, Jordan River

There is nothing quite like watching a sunrise in the Galilee from our hotel. We begin our sightseeing with our first stop visit at the **Mt. of Beatitudes** (Matt. 5-7), with time for reflection and worship. From here we make our way to **Capernaum**, We then board our replica wooden Jesus Boat for our **Boat Ride on the Sea of Galilee**, we then stop for a special traditional St. Peter's Fish lunch. Afterwards we see **Gadara** and then make our way to the **River Jordan**. We will have dinner and overnight in Tiberias.

Day 4 - Thursday: Golan Heights, Caesarea Philippi, Tel Dan, Tiberias

After breakfast we travel north for the **Golan Heights** and view the area from a special lookout. From here we continue our drive to **Caesarea Philippi**, where we will have time for devotion; afterwards we have a short hike/walk to **Tel Dan** where we will see the gate of Jeroboam. From here we will include a visit to **Gideon Springs**. We stop in Jericho for a brief visit. Afterwards, time permitting we end our days sightseeing with a visit to **Tel Beit Shean**,

one of the best preserved Decapolis Roman cities. Dinner and overnight in Tiberias.

Day 5 - Friday: Galilee, Cana, Nazareth, Druze Lunch stop, Mt. Carmel, Megiddo, Caesarea Maritima, Jerusalem

Today we depart the Galilee, visiting the following biblical sites: **Cana** (John 2), here we continue to **Zippori**, **Nazareth** (Luke 1 & 2), **Mt. Carmel** with time for devotions (1 Kgs. 18), if time permits we'll stop at the Druze Village for a short lunch break (not included), afterwards we make our way to **Tel Megiddo**, **Caesarea Maritima** (Acts 9 & 25), from here we make our way up to majestic city of **Jerusalem** in time for dinner and overnight in Jerusalem.

Day 6 - Saturday: Mt. of Olives, Palm Sunday Road, Garden of Gethsemane, Mt. Zion Gate, Jewish Quarter, Temple Mount, Bethlehem

We begin our explorations with a drive to the beautiful **Mt. of Olives** to behold the breathtaking panorama of the Holy City. Our pilgrimage will proceed on our own the Old Palm Sunday Road to the **Garden of Gethsemane** with its ancient olive grove, and there visit the **Church of Agony**, where tradition holds that Jesus prayed. We will enter Jerusalem through the Zion Gate, and walk to the holiest site in the whole Jewish world, the **Western Wall** (Wailing Wall) of Herod's temple. Beyond the wall lies the 35 acre temple area purchased by King David (2 Sam. 24:18-25). On this site now stands the magnificent **Dome of the Rock** (the third holiest shrine in all Islam) and the El-Aksa Mosque.

From the temple area, we make our way to the **Church of the Holy Sepulchre** and then onto St. Stephen's Gate, **St. Anne's Crusader Church**, **Pools of Bethesda**, the **Sister of Zion Convent** (to see the Pavement where Jesus stood as he was being tried by Pilate), **Ecco Homo Arch**, and the ancient **Cardo**. Afterwards a short walk takes

us to the **Southern Steps** to stand on the original steps that Jesus walked on as he entered the Temple area. We conclude our sightseeing with a short drive and visit to **Bethlehem**, we will pass by **Rachel's tomb** on the outskirts of Bethlehem, and visit the **Church of the Nativity** and **Shepherd's Field**. We will have dinner and overnight in Jerusalem. After dinner we make our way back to the Western Wall for a visit to the **Rabbi's Tunnel**.

Day 7 - Sunday: Ein Gedi, Qumran, Masada, Dead Sea - Swim/Float, Yad Vashem

After our breakfast, we begin our day of sightseeing with a visit to **Ein Gedi** where David hid from King Saul. From here we make our way to **Qumran** and the possible settlement of the first century sect known as the Essenes, the authors of the Dead Sea Scrolls. Following the road south along the western shore of the Dead Sea, we will stop and visit **Masada**, where we will ascend high upon the wilderness mountain by way of the cable car to the fortress built by King Herod. Here we survey the ruins of the fortifications, waterworks, synagogue, temples and palaces.

Time permitting, we will make a special stop at the **Dead Sea** (also referred to as the lowest spot on the earth) for a short swim/float (please be sure you bring with you good water/closed end shoes, as the bottom surface can be rough on your feet). Afterwards we make our way back to Jerusalem. The road from the Dead Sea area to Jerusalem is an ascent of 4,000 feet in 13 miles. If time permits we'll include a short visit to **Jericho** (conditions permitting). Upon arrival in Jerusalem, we will continue to **Yad Vashem Holocaust Memorial**, prior to arriving at our hotel in time for dinner and overnight in Jerusalem.

Day 8 - Monday: Shrine of the Book, Model City, Hezekiah's Tunnel, St. Peter Gallicantu, Garden Tomb

After breakfast we begin our sightseeing with a visit to the **Shrine of the Book Museum**, where the Dead Sea Scrolls are displayed, then you will be fascinated by your visit to a **model of Jerusalem** (1 to 50 scale model of Herodian Jerusalem as it would have appeared in Jesus' time), afterwards we drive to **Hezekiah's Tunnel** (or shaft, conditions permitting) for a visit (please be sure to bring good water shoes with you, as you will get wet walking through the tunnel, also be sure to bring a flashlight with you if at possible). From here we make our way to the **Church of Agony** at **St. Peter Gallicantu**. Afterwards we make our way to the **Garden Tomb** for time of worship and communion. We conclude our day with a farewell dinner and overnight in Jerusalem.

Day 9 - Tuesday: Jerusalem - Elah Valley - Jaffa - Ben Gurion Airport for return flight

Morning at leisure in Jerusalem, depart Jerusalem, and begin our sightseeing with a visit to the **Elah Valley**, where David slew Goliath. Drive to **Jaffa** for a **special farewell dinner** at the Old Men and the Sea Restaurant or similar. Transfer to Ben Gurion airport for your flight back to the USA.

Day 10 - Wednesday: Arrive back in USA

The close of an unforgettable tour, we bring with us lasting memories of the Old and New Testament, a renewal of our faith, and a greater understanding of the life and ministry of our Lord.
